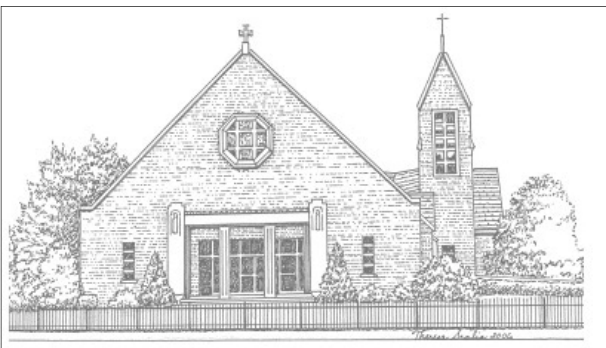

#### 2011 Susi Award

**Robert Daniel Halloran, Jr.** is this year's recipient of the **Marc A. Susi Award!** Each year this award is presented to a member of the Confirmation class who, in the judgment of the Faith Formation Staff, has made exemplary preparation for the reception of the Sacrament of Confirmation. A sincere and faithful practice of the Catholic faith is also a qualification for this award. Attendance at Sunday Mass is inherent with such practice. The award is given in memory of **Marc A. Susi**, a well-known and respected member of the community who died 19 years ago. As a young man, Marc had a profound impact on his peers who hold him in great respect to this day.

**Catholics Come Home**— This week we hear about water and thirst. With all of the precipitation this winter has brought, it is hard to imagine being thirsty. The Samaritan woman at the well is an important figure in the Gospel. She is an evangelist *par excellence* leaving her water jug to tell the townspeople what she had heard.
